



DISPATCHER, PUBLIC SAFETY (BASIC)

This course is designed for law enforcement dispatchers and is available to self-sponsored students based upon qualification. Self-sponsored students must be a minimum 18 years old, have no felony convictions, no misdemeanor convictions involving weapon violations or acts of physical violence and have a valid driver's license or ID card.

This course is a basic overview of public safety dispatching and satisfies the July 1, 2011 revised curriculum set by the Peace Officer Standards and training for basic public safety and dispatching. You will earn **6.0 units of college credits**.
