



FIREARMS TACTICAL RIFLE BASIC (AR-15/M16)

Must be currently employed by a law enforcement agency as a sworn peace officer. California compliant rifles or rifles with "bullet buttons" are not allowed.

This course will provide students with the basic skills and knowledge necessary to safely and tactically deploy an M-16/AR-15 style patrol rifle in the field. This course will include the use of classroom instruction and practical application on the range. Topics covered: department policy and procedure, case law, force options, legal and moral options when deploying patrol rifle, ammunition and expectations, The patrol rifle use and nomenclature of weapon system, weapons breakdown/maintenance, safe handling of rifle. Students will practice using their patrol rifle in several scenarios. Successful completion of the course satisfies the legislative mandate to possess short barrel rifle as specified in Penal Code section 33220(b) and the P.O.S.T. requirement in Regulation 1081.
